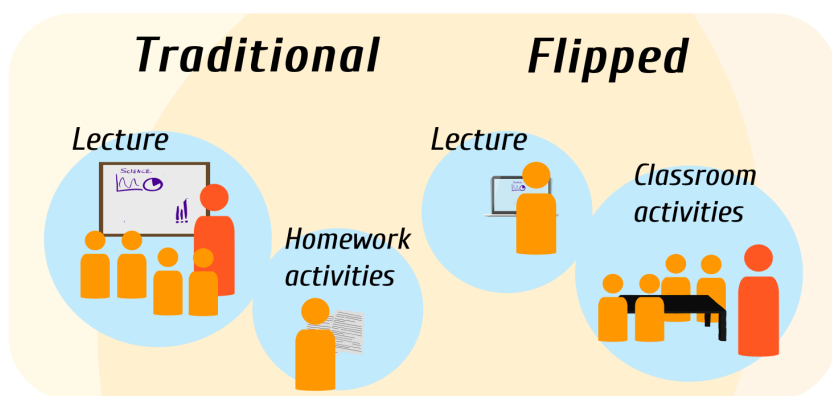
### **ICT WORKSHOP**

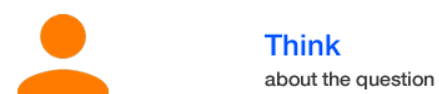
